

# Ignition and Kick-Start Program (Revised 27th September 2014)



### FEATURES

- •The Ignition and Kick-Start Programs at Venture Center aim to nurture and advance technology projects that have significant potential for being incorporated into independent start-up ventures after reducing certain uncertainties or technology de-risking following more proof-of-concept studies or aggregating certain key missing components prior to new venture creation.
- The Venture Center will assist project teams in achieving their goals depending upon the specific needs of each project team. These services shall be provided against terms announced separately by Venture Center for each of these services.
  - oGeneral advise and mentoring
  - oGuidance in raising funding—especially grant funding
  - oAssistance in trying to find potential partners and finalizing arrangements between partners
  - oServices and analytics support relating to IPR
  - oAssistance in market research and business planning
  - oCompany formation and management
  - oAccess to facilities, resources, programs, networks etc of the Venture Center
- •Venture Center shall provide its services on the assumption that the project team will raise funding (ex: grant funding) so as to also accommodate Venture Center's listed costs in offering those services

#### **MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA & ELIGIBILITY**

The Venture Center is selective in admitting members into its Ignition and Kick-Start Programs.

Eligibility criteria include:

• Early-stage technology results with considerable commercial potential.

Preferably, with provisional patents already filed.

- •Category 1: For Projects at Pre-Incorporation Stage:
  - •Clear commitment of the project team to creating a new start-up venture if the Ignition program yields positive results.
  - •One key person in the project team who takes responsibility for creating the new startup venture at the end of the Ignition program if the program yields positive results.
  - The project team has to ensure that the rules of the parent organization or employer do not prevent them from creating a company and/or sourcing the technology under consideration.
  - oA company has not already been created.
  - •Category 2: Young (less than 3 years), technology (knowledge intensive) start-up companies

The "Entrepreneurship Development Center" is incorporated under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956 (India). "Venture Center is a member of the Indian STEP and Business Incubator Association (ISBA) and the National Business Incubation Association (NBIA)."



- •At this time, the Venture Center is able to only support a limited number of projects/ potential companies under this program at any given time.
- •The Venture Center reserves the rights to refuse any application without providing a reason.

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- •Minimum: 1 year
- •Clients shall receive first 5 hours (Man hours) of advisory services free of cost. After the first 5 hours are over, Ignition members will be charged at a subsidized rate of Rs 200 per hour of mentoring session time and Kick-start members will be charged at a rate of Rs 1500 per hour of mentoring session.
- Payment:
- oAdvance payment for 1 year at a time.
- oAutomatic 1 year extension if not closed 1 month in advance.
