

David Green, a MacArthur and Ashoka Fellow, is a social entrepreneur committed to making healthcare affordable and accessible. He co-founded Aurolab (India), restoring vision for over 40 million people, and serves as CTO of KeraLink International, focusing on corneal blindness. David has launched impactful ventures like Sound World Solutions (affordable hearing aids) and LegWorks (low-cost prosthetic knees) and collaborates with WHO on reducing medical costs. A University of Michigan alumnus, he has received numerous global awards for his contributions to healthcare innovation.
