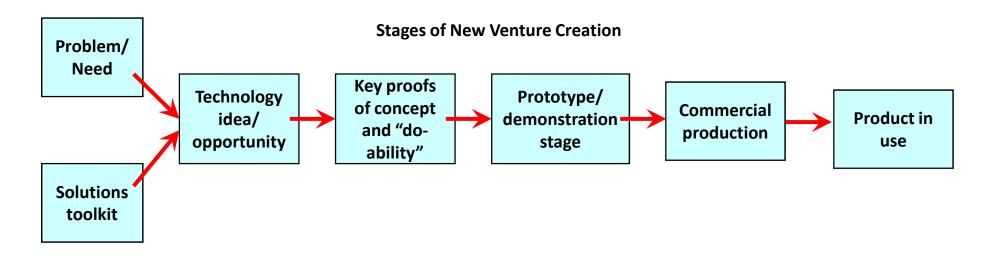
#### TePP selection criteria

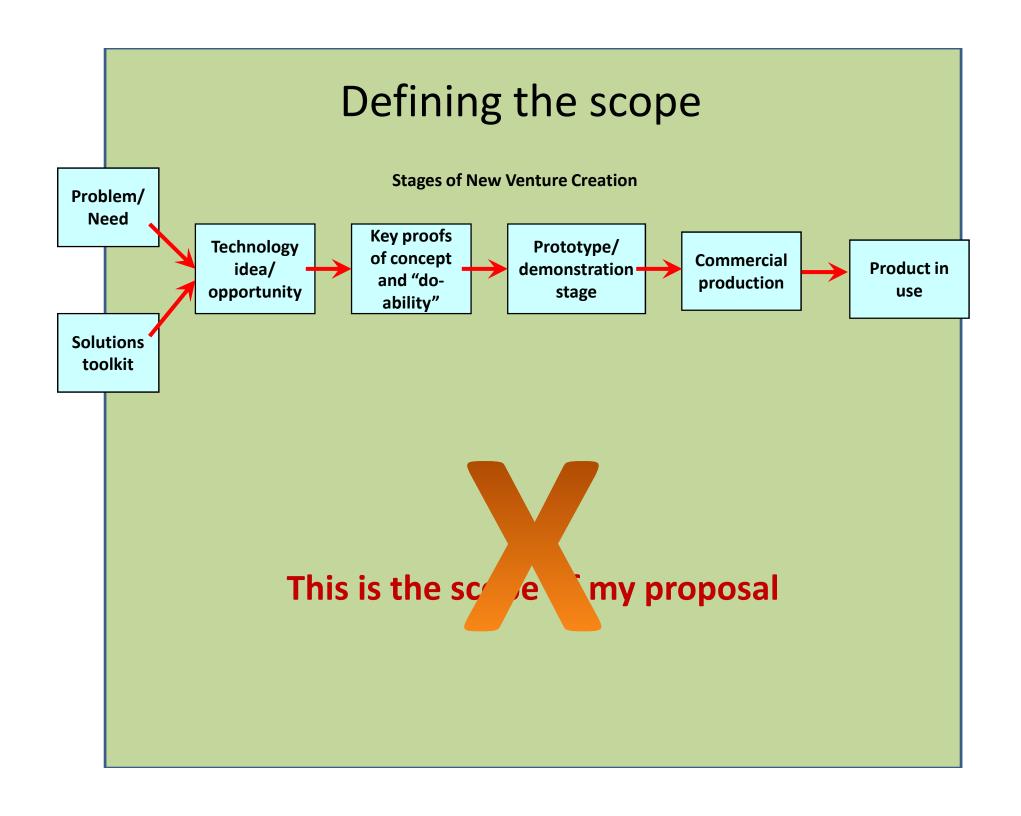
- Technology based idea
- Should have potential applications/ Identification of target customers
- Innovativeness & novelty
- Technical & commercial viability
- Credibility of innovator to deliver
- Funding request is reasonable/ realistic

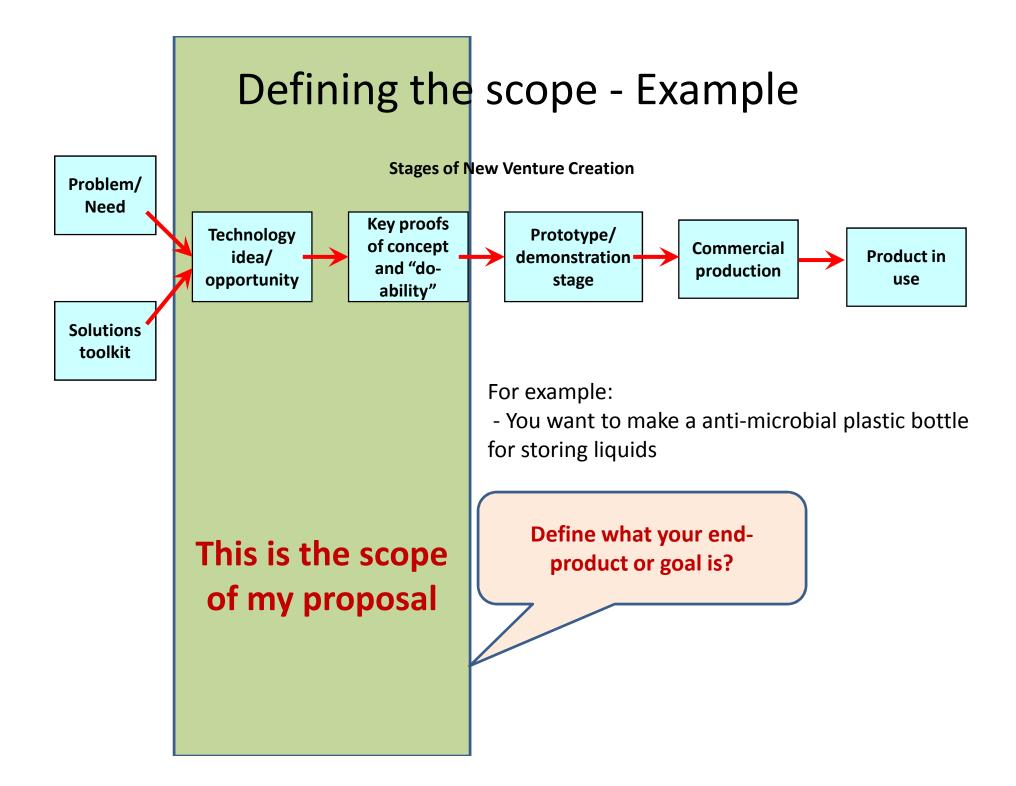
### Knowing your audience – who will read your proposal

 You want to make antimicrobial plastic bottle for storing liquids

# Example of scope of TePP Proposal

 To synthesize a few 100 gms of anti-microbial polymer and make a few prototypes (sample bottles) and test with 2-3 commonly used beverages

#### Is your idea/product innovative?

- Please explain why your idea is innovative?
- How is it different from existing products in the market?
- Please make a table as below, comparing your idea to other products in the market

Cost	Low	High	Low
Performance	High	Low	Moderate

#### Thinking about a proposal

- Please list the various steps that will be required to reach your end-product/goal
- This will also define the *milestones* and could help you implement your proposal



- How will you prepare your prototype?
- How will you test your idea? What are the facilities needed?

#### Resources Required

- How much will it cost to reach your end-goal
- Break-up of all the costs
  - Equipment
  - Consumables
  - •Consultant?

You are here today



This is my endproduct /goal

- Please provide justification for the resources asked for?
- Quotes from vendors, consultants
- Product price from available sources (catalogue)
- What are the equipment needed? For what purpose?

#### Timeline of the proposal

- How long will it take to reach your goal?
- If it is more than 6 months, please put intermediate milestones

#### Starting to write a proposal

- What is the problem you are addressing/solving (one or two paragraphs)?
- What is the solution you are providing (a brief description of your idea)
- Why is it innovative/novel?
- What are the potential applications?
- What is the end-product or goal of this proposal?
- How you propose to go about executing the proposal?
- What are the resources required? Timeline?
- Your/your team's CV or resume

#### How much data should you provide?

- Enough for a technology expert to read your proposal and evaluate
  - If the idea is credible/technically feasible
  - Is innovative and novel
  - Do you/your team have the necessary background to execute the project?
  - Are the resources asked for justifiable?
  - Is there potential commercial application for this idea?
  - Is the timeline specified reasonable?

#### Formatting tips

- Write in short paragraphs
- Use bullet points make it easier for the reviewer to read it
- If you need to provide more information, please put an attachment/appendix and say in your main proposal "for details, please refer to Appendix 1/2/3 etc.)
- Put tables and illustrations if possible
